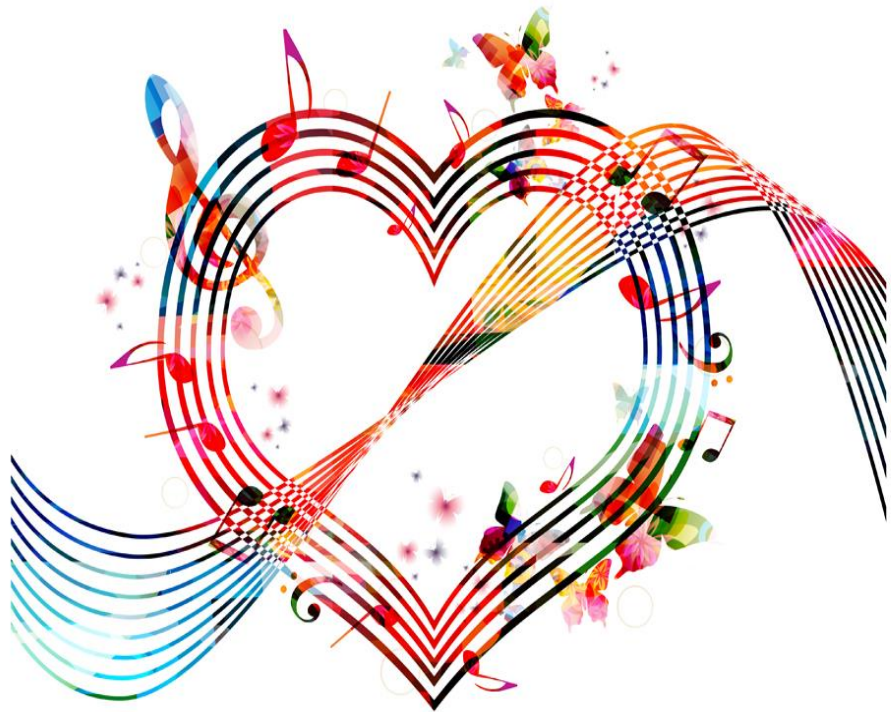

These scholarships are renewable upon teacher recommendation.

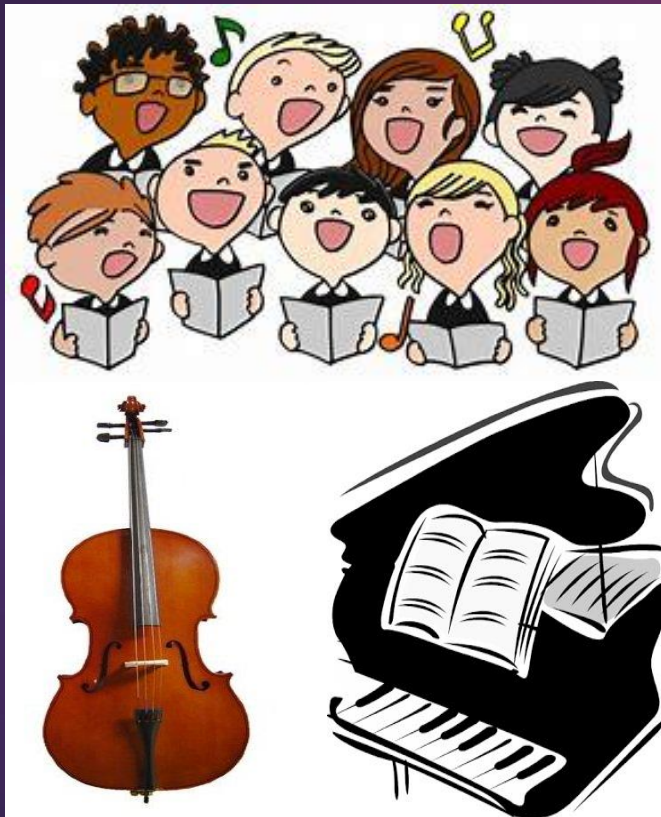
