Born in Sarasota, Florida in 1968, Mark Hetzler began playing his father's trombone at the age of twelve. As a member of the Empire Brass Quintet from 1996 2012, Mark performed in recital and as a soloist with symphony orchestras in Australia, Taiwan, South Korea, China, Venezuela, Brazil, Japan, Hong Kong, Germany, Italy, Austria, Malaysia, Singapore, Switzerland, Bermuda, St. Bartholomew and across the United States. Mark has released twelve solo recordings on the Summit Records label with programming that features music in a wide variety of genres. In addition to recording and performing, Mark is active as a composer, orchestrator and arranger, fusing classical styles with many non-classical influences. He is the Professor of Trombone at the University of Wisconsin Madison and a member of the Wisconsin Brass Quintet.
