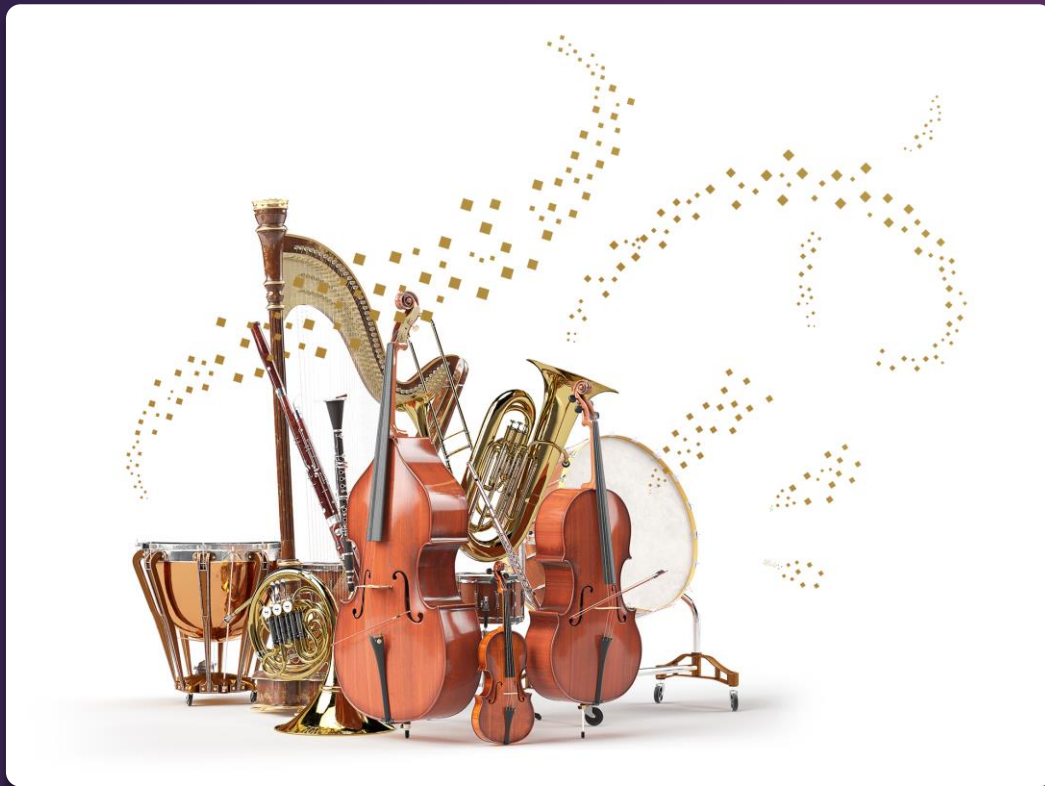

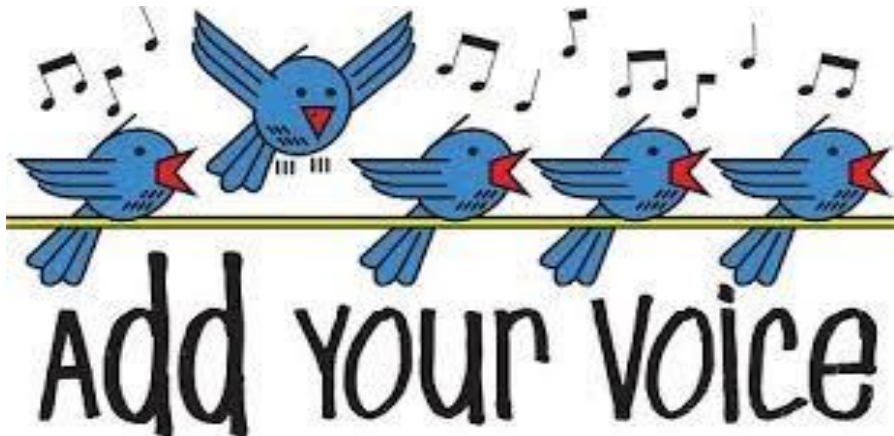

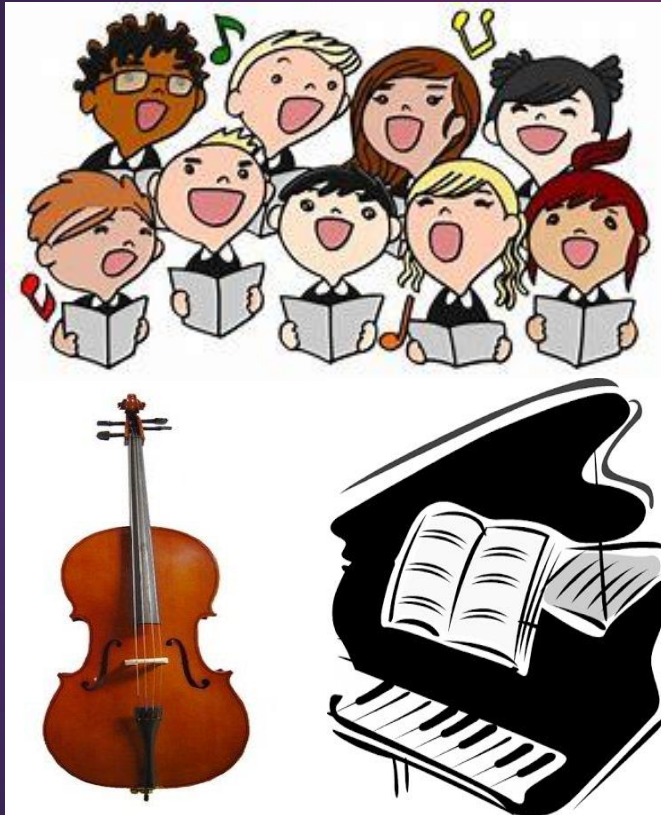
## **MUSIC PARTY** for **ADULT STUDENTS** and **TEACHERS**
