from 1958-1960.**

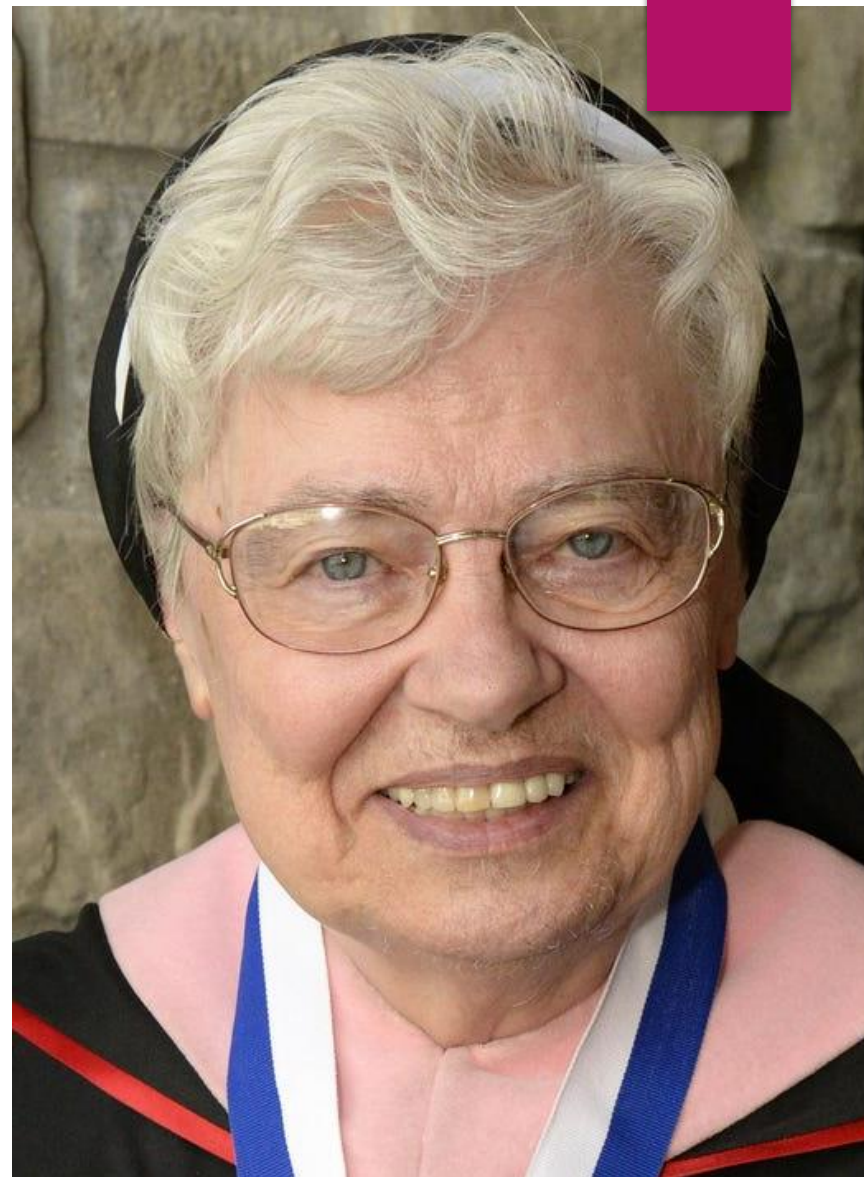
Sister Marella Wagner passed away last Saturday, June 27, 2020

She was honored with professor emeritus status at Silver Lake/Holy Family College. Sister Marella earned her Bachelor of Music degree from Silver Lake College in 1962 and received her Master of Music degree from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 1969.

She began serving as a full-time faculty member at Silver Lake College in 1966 and went on to become chair of the Faculty Development Committee, coordinator of the college's Division of Arts and Sciences, and chair of the Department of Music.

Sister Marella was a member of the international, national and Midwest Kodály associations. In addition, she wrote about music for numerous publications, and studied and gave presentations about music in various places both in the United States and other countries.

Sister Marella was a dear friend for many of us. We will miss her incredibly. May she rest in peace!
